

I. Caring for your LED Superhoop

1. When your hoop arrives, carefully remove the packaging. Take extra care if using scissors – they can scratch the tape.
2. Just peel off the tape and switch cover and switch to on.
NOTE: We highly recommend securing your switch when the hoop is not in use. It can get bumped on and drain your batteries without you noticing.
3. Play! Your hoop is sturdy, but you'll still want to treat it like the hundred dollar toy it is. (**Remember, your hoop and switch are plastic!**). As with all hoops, avoid hooping on concrete.

II. Changing the Batteries in your LED Superhoop

Be sure that you are opening the end of the hoop that is not near the switch.

Fig. 2 Cut a 2nd vertical line to the end of tape.

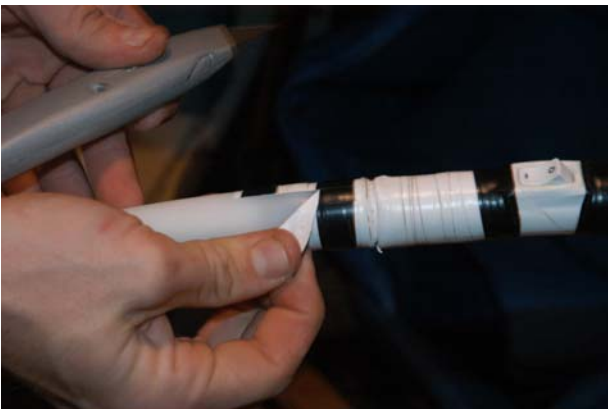


Fig. 3 Peel back the tape.



Fig. 4 HEAT the end of the pipe using a lighter, hair dryer, or other heat source. Pull open the connector. If the pipe does not open easily, continue heating.

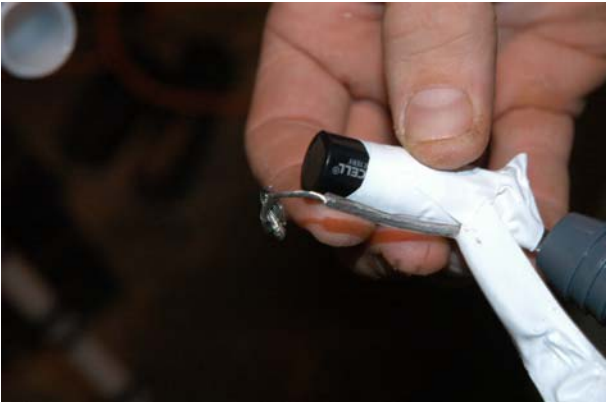


Fig. 5 Peel back the tape around battery pack.

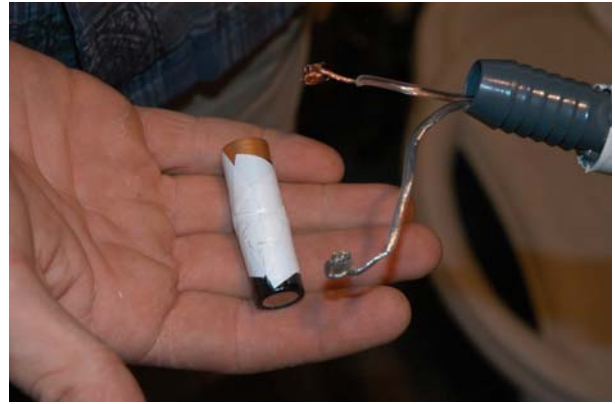


Fig. 6 Note that copper is positive (nipple end). Silver is negative (flat end)

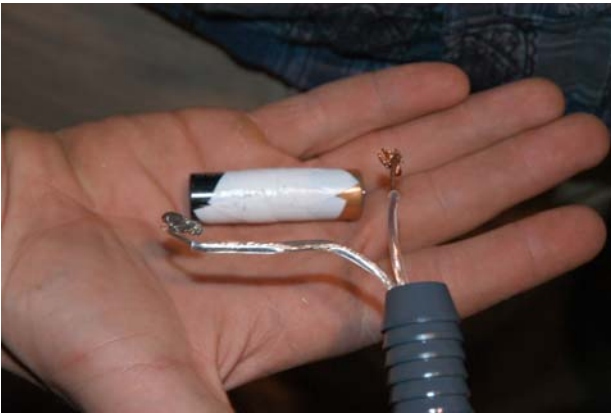


Fig. 7 Use electrical tape to tape two CR2 batteries end to end and re-tape connecting the wires to the appropriate ends, just as they were.

Now reconnect the hoop by heating the end and pushing together tightly.

Re-tape or follow the optional, but recommended directions below.



Figs. 8-9 If the fit seems a bit loose (re-heating can sometimes do this), we recommend drilling a small hole and fitting the connection with a screw.
